Allt-a-Bhainne (2006) A dreamy nighttime drink Cask 108.34 - The Scotch Malt Whisky Society

The Allt-a-Bhainne 2006 A Dreamy Nighttime Drink (Cask 108.34) from the renowned Scotch Malt Whisky Society encapsulates the quintessence of the Speyside region in an impressive single malt matured for 14 years. With a powerful alcohol content of 64.4% ABV, this whisky is not for the faint-hearted, but an experience for connoisseurs who want to engage with complex worlds of flavours.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

From the very first sniff, the whisky reveals an unusual but fascinating palette of flavours. A hint of WD40 - industrial but not overpowering - is paired with floral notes and sweet honey. A hint of roasted sugar is reminiscent of a crème brûlée crust, while vanilla ice cream and coconut add a tropical accent. A subliminal scent of Marsala rounds off the olfactory experience.

PALATE

This whisky envelops the palate with its oily, smooth mouthfeel. Notes of honey and malt come to the fore, while subtle floral nuances and a light spiciness unfold. The sweetness on the lips gives the whisky a pleasant balance, while a hint of hay adds a refreshing, earthy component. Despite the high alcohol content, the flavour remains soft and inviting.

FINISH

The finish is long, flowing and warming - a real highlight that emphasises the character of the whisky.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

The Allt-a-Bhainne 2006 impresses with its intense aroma and smooth mouthfeel, turning every sip into a moment of enjoyment. Despite its powerful 64.4% ABV, it remains surprisingly approachable and invites relaxed lingering in the evening. A true dream for anyone who loves their whisky with character and warmth.

SASCHA

With a remarkable balance between intense aromatic density and soft texture, the Allt-a-Bhainne 2006 showcases its technical finesse. The harmonious blend of sweet, floral, and spicy notes, along with a long-lasting, warming finish, makes it a structured single malt offering complex moments of enjoyment. Ideal for connoisseurs who appreciate precise composition and depth.
