Distilled in Australia 7 Years (2024) The Tasteful 8 - Brühler Whiskyhaus

Australian whisky has received more and more attention in recent years - and for good reason. The climatic conditions ensure accelerated maturation, which often leads to intense and unique flavour profiles.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

The first impression is unusual and complex: umami notes, old leather shoes and mushrooms - that may sound daring, but it adds depth. There are also clear spicy and herbal notes reminiscent of Mediterranean cuisine. Caramel and a hint of solvent then emerge in the background.

PALATE

On the tongue, the whisky shows its intense side. Oily, very dry and fruity at the same time - a mixture that creates tension. The fruitiness is present, but it does not go in the typical sherry or tropical direction, but rather remains on the dense, concentrated side. The dryness gives it a sophisticated, almost tannic structure.

FINISH

The finish is earthy with notes of chilli and pepper. A pleasant warmth remains, but oak is barely noticeable - which is not surprising for a 7-years whisky from Australia.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

This Australian whisky is a true adventure in a glass - with its umami notes and spicy dryness, it challenges the drinker and rewards with a distinctive character. Those looking for straightforward sweetness should move along, but explorers will find plenty of drinking pleasure and an exciting flavor expedition here.

SASCHA

The Tasteful 8 demonstrates a remarkable balance between intense dryness and dense fruitiness, with spicy and earthy nuances providing a complex structure. Despite its youth, it impresses with a precise aromatic profile that, far from classic vanilla or sherry tones, occupies a unique position within Australian whiskies.
