## Distilled in Ireland 21 Years (2024) The Tasteful 8 - Brühler Whiskyhaus

Irish whiskey is known for its smooth, fruity notes and often triple distillation. However, with 21 years of maturation and a stately 49.7% ABV, this bottling from Brühler Whiskyhaus brings an exciting depth. Matured in an excellent bourbon cask, it promises complex flavours and an intense taste experience. Sounds promising - so pour it into your glass!

### TASTING NOTES

#### NOSE

The very first impression is a tropical-sweet revelation. Coconut, brown sugar and stone fruit characterise the bouquet. These are joined by honeydew melon, waxy notes, molasses and caramel - a wonderfully dense and elegant fragrance. A hint of passion fruit adds a refreshing, exotic nuance.

#### PALATE

Things get really exciting on the palate: strawberry pez meets fruity fruit salad juice, accompanied by an oily, almost buttery texture. A gentle pinch of tingle adds vibrancy, while the oak perfectly balances the sweetness with its spicy depth. A complex but wonderfully accessible flavour!

#### FINISH

The finish is long and sweet, with gentle oak notes that slowly drift off in a pleasantly spicy, slightly darker direction. Not an abrupt end, but a smooth, enjoyable finish.

### THOUGHTS

#### MARCEL

You can practically feel the pure joy of drinking here - fruity, sweet, and with an oily, buttery texture that's simply a pleasure. This isn't a boring standard release but a truly lively dram that impresses with character and charm. For anyone looking for a multifaceted Irish whiskey off the beaten path, this is a real bullseye!

#### SASCHA

A successful interplay of tropical fruit and spicy oak showcases the high quality of the bourbon cask. The complexity remains well balanced throughout, with a harmonious finish that is neither overpowering nor flat. Solid structure and refined aromatics make this 21-years Irish whiskey a sophisticated enjoyment.
