TASTING NOTES

NOSE

A seductive aroma caresses the senses and immediately captivates us. Even at the first impression, the scent of ripe sherry unfolds, gently harmonizing with a subtle wine-like quality and reminiscent of the complexity of a well-aged wine. As we dive deeper into the olfactory experience, an earthy undertone emerges, evoking thoughts of fresh earth, while a pronounced woodiness recalls decayed wood and further deepens the complexity. This multifaceted aromatic profile gradually develops and invites us to explore the various facets that intertwine harmoniously. With each breath, the experience intensifies, and we feel the rich aromas dancing together, preparing us for a flavorful journey.

PALATE

With the first sip, a smooth interplay of flavors unfolds, gently caressing the tongue and immediately captivating us. Delicate wood notes blend with the intense depth of dark chocolate, while a tingling sensation enlivens the senses and stimulates the taste buds. Gradually, nutty nuances of hazelnuts join in, accompanied by a gentle sweetness reminiscent of vanilla pudding, further deepening the complexity of the enjoyment. This delicate balance between the various components creates a dynamic interaction that unfolds with each subsequent sip, inviting us to explore the rich facets. Finally, the finish leaves a warm aftertaste of dates and a hint of coffee that lingers long and impressively underscores the depth of this remarkable experience.

FINISH
